SUBMIT MHWOW PROGRAMS BY 9/12

Yom Kippur, usually expressed in English as "Day of Atonement," is the holiest day of the year in Judaism.

SUKKOT

SUBMIT MHWOW PROGRAMS BY 9/18

Sukkot celebrates the gathering of the harvest and commemorates the Jews being protected when they left Egypt.

SHEMINI ATZERET

BEGINS AT SUNDOWN ON
SEPTEMBER

30 

SUBMIT MHWOW PROGRAMS BY 9/25

Shemini Atzeret immediately follows the 7-day Sukkot celebration as it can be translated to "eighth day of assembly." It is a separate- yet connected- day devoted to spiritual aspects of Sukkot.
